A Word from Pastor Jon



March will begin our season of Lent. Lent is a season of preparation and repentance during which we anticipate Good Friday and Easter. Just as many of you carefully prepare for big events in your life, such as a wedding or commencement, Lent invites us to make our hearts ready for remembering Jesus' passion and celebrating Jesus' resurrection.

The practice of a forty-day preparation period began in the Christian church during the third and fourth centuries. The number forty carries biblical significance based on the forty years Israel spent in the wilderness and Jesus' forty-day fast in the wilderness as his preparation for his public ministry. The forty days of Lent begin with our Ash Wednesday service held at Prairie Chapel on March 5th at 7:00PM. Lent continues through holy week, not counting Sundays which are reserved for worship celebration.

We will prepare our hearts by taking a fresh look at a famous parable found in Luke chapter 15, the parable of the Prodigal Son based on the book *The Prodigal God* by Timothy Keller.

We will find this text and Lenten series contains the essentials of the Christian message no matter if you are new to the faith or a lifelong believer. In fact you may be surprised by the fresh approach to this passage.

If the adjective Prodigal means recklessly extravagant or having spent everything, then it really is not the son that is prodigal, but as we will discover over the 6 week series, it is God that is the Prodigal. In this story Jesus is showing us the God who is prodigal toward us, his children. God's reckless grace is our greatest hope. Will you join me in prayer that this Lenten season and series will be a good time of preparation for Holy Week and Easter and a time of personal transformation as we all better understand God's extravagant grace towards us.


