

A Word from Pastor Jon

A Call to Unplug

Perhaps you recall returning to work after vacation and you find all kinds of work that has piled up waiting for your return. So many emails and messages and the list goes on. Before you realize it, your first couple days have been spent in front of a computer screen and you may have had little interaction with people. You know the feeling. We spend a lot more time in front of electronic devices than we think. Next time you're in a waiting room look around at the people who are looking at their phone.

Adele Calhoun in her book *Spiritual Disciplines Handbook* says "Normalcy includes having a cell phone, which makes me available and interruptible at meals, in the middle of conversations, in meetings" (p. 86). We have truly become interruptible and in addition to that, our work load and desire for efficiency often drives us to more faceless communication.

During this Lenten season I would like to ask you to join me in setting aside some time to unplug your electronic devices and talk to people face to face. Go visit someone. Use this time for reading scripture and having a prayer time. Pray for your family, friends, community, your church, your Pastor (who always needs your prayer). You can read *Cultivating Fruitfulness*, the devotional book we're reading together, as a congregation, during our Lent. Unplug from the electronic devices and plug into your spiritual life. We were created for personal interaction by a personal God. Too often we settle for times and relationships that circumstances will permit rather than intentional action on our part. We all need these uninterrupted spaces in our lives for the presence of God and others. I hope that you will join me in this effort because this practice of unplugging from some of the distractions and plugging into the presence of God can be a discipline that transforms us. Share with me and others how it goes!




