Saturday: That God's compassion and grace will become the characteristics by which we as individuals and as a church are known


Will you join me? Be creative in how you find a way to remind yourself to pray.

Bible Study Book of James – Practical Christianity continues:

Prairie Chapel May 31, June 14, June 21, June 28 from 2:00–3:30PM.

Alburnett Tuesday, June 2, Monday, June 15, 22, 29 from 6:30–8:00pm.

The purpose of this study is to present the practical message of James as found in his New Testament epistle and understand its

implications for life today.

This study is a participatory study for students who want a challenging study. A variety of commentaries, Bible dictionaries, and reference materials will be made available for their use. This short term study will be conducted over 4-5 weeks with each session lasting approximately 90 minutes.

Some of the objectives of this study are:

Present a basic overview of the book of James including background, themes, and unique characteristics.


Students will become familiar with the use of study tools such as a study Bible, study guides, Bible dictionary, and a Bible commentary.

Students will discuss the relationship between what we believe and how we behave based on the teaching of James.

Compare and contrast what the letter of James says about "faith and works" with what is said about "faith and works" in Paul's letters.

MISSION PROJECT-SEWING KITS: All items must be new.

- •3 continuous yards of fabric (Cotton or cotton blend only; No heavy duty, corduroy, knit, etc. No patriotic, religious, holiday, camouflage, or military patterned fabric please.)
- •1 pair fabric scissors •1 spool thread, medium to large spool;
- •1 package hand sewing needles in original packaging.
- •5-8 buttons, 5/8-inch size or larger; No loose buttons; Leave buttons in original packaging or fasten all together.
- •1 One-gallon size sealable bag.

Place kit in the plastic bag and seal.
