A Word from Pastor Jon



Ordination

I want to offer a word of thanks for all the cards and special recognition that you blessed me with on the special occasion of my ordination. I was really touched by the many cards and personal messages I received. I thank you so much for that and for being with me in this sacred moment of Ordination.

So what does Ordination mean? To me ordination is recognition and service. Ordination is the church's recognition of your call to ministry. An Ordained elder is called to the church and to people. The Book of Discipline says that *Ordination to this ministry is a gift from God to the church. In ordination, the church affirms*

and continues the apostolic ministry through persons empowered by the Holy Spirit.

For those like myself, who have felt called to ministry and have entered a process of examination so that the church can evaluate ones gifts and graces for ministry and at the same time we pursued higher education and various other requirements, ordination is the fulfillment of this part of the journey of faith. The laying on of hands with the prayer of Bishops, Elders, and colleagues along with the historic words of the Bishop to "take thou authority", is a powerful moment. It marks a life of leadership in "Service, Word, Sacrament, and Order.

But the seal of ordination is <u>not</u> a sign of special holiness, or a mark of being set aside for a special position in <u>the culture of the Church</u>. Ordained persons are authorized to preach and teach the word of God, to administer the Sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion, equip and mentor the laity for ministry, exercise responsible pastoral oversight, and diligently administer the Discipline of the Church.

<u>Ordination is also service</u>. I, like all followers of Christ, am called to a life of discipleship to love and serve others. Ordination is the sacred moment when the church marks the transition of those called to pastoral leadership or some other form of specialized ministry within the body of Christ. It is important to remember that the Ordained are NOT above and NOT below the laity but, set apart for pastoral leadership.

It is my honor to be called to service our Lord right here at Alburnett & Prairie Chapel, shoulder to shoulder with you. Thank you for the love and support that you have shown me.

UMCOR 2015 School Kit Materials

- 1 pair blunt scissors (Rounded tip only; No plastic scissors, please.)
- 3 pads of paper (Spiral or top-bound pads; 150 sheets or less of loose-leaf paper can be substituted for 1 pad; Combination of spiral, top-bound, side-bound, or loose-leaf paper is acceptable; No composition books.)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (Must be at least 1 inch long; Remove from packaging.)
- 1 30-centimeter ruler (Hard or flexible)
- 6 unsharpened pencils
- 1 2-inch or larger-size eraser (
- 1 24-count box of crayons (Only 24-count boxes, please.)
- 1 14x16 inch cloth bag (Homemade or purchased bags are both acceptable; Heavy-duty fabric only, such as denim, corduroy, drapery fabric, etc.; Closures are optional but must be buttons, snaps, or Velcro sewn in middle of opening, if used.

Assembly Directions

Place all loose items on top of paper. Turn items sideways and slide into the cloth bag. Fold over the top of the bag so loose items don't fall out.

Important Notes

All items must be new.

- No advertisements, religious, patriotic, military, or camouflage symbols, please; Cartoon characters are acceptable.
- All emergency kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules often govern product entry into international countries, it is important that kits contain only the requested items, nothing more.
- Do not include any personal notes, money, or additional material in the kits. These things must be painstakingly removed and will delay the shipment.


