INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY: Winter is fast approaching and it's time for us to be reminded how we will communicate to you when inclement weather forces us to cancel or delay our Sunday worship service and classes, we will post such notice in the

Of course, we also want to encourage everyone to make good, safe decisions regardless of whether we cancel the worship service or not.




