A Word from Pastor Jon



Holy week is fast approaching us as we continue our Lenten journey this year with the theme of **BOOT CAMP FOR THE SOUL**. This time of preparation continues through Holy Week. The first Sunday of Holy Week is commonly called either "Palm Sunday" or "Passion Sunday." There is a duel emphasis during Holy Week as reflected in the two

names for the first Sunday of Holy week. Palm Sunday focus is on the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem to the shouts of "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Mark 11:9). The "Passion Sunday" focus is on Jesus' suffering. Both moods are present in Holy Week.

Then we come to what is known as *The Great Three Days* "sometimes called the Triduum or Pasch—from sunset Holy Thursday through sunset Easter Day are the climax of Lent (and of the whole Christian year) and a bridge into the Easter Season. These days proclaim the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ's passion, death, and resurrection¹. During these days, the community journeys with Jesus from the upper room, to the cross, to the tomb, and to the garden.

We have special services planned for Holy Week that provide you the opportunity to draw closer to Christ. I want to invite you to participate in the Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Services as a way in which we pay attention to what Jesus Christ has done for us through his passion, death, and resurrection.
