A Word from Pastor Jon



What it Means to be Created in the Image of God

When we look back at the creation story found in Genesis chapter 1, we see that we have been created in God's own image (Genesis 1:26-27).

What it doesn't mean is that we look like God or that God looks physically like us. The Scripture tells us that God is Spirit (John 4:24). God is neither male nor female, which is why we try not to over

use male pronouns when referring to God.

So, what does it mean to be made in the image of God? Dr. Timothy Tennent in his book, *Thirty Questions*,* says that being created in the image of God generally refers to three distinct capacities that have been granted to the human race.

- 1. <u>Spiritual capacity</u> We were meant to reflect God's nature in the world. We are to mirror God's image in the world-God's love, grace, and holiness.
- 2. <u>God is relational</u> We have the capacity to know God by God's grace, and to communicate with God. We have the capacity to be in relationship. We can love God and neighbor.
- 3. The image of God gives us the capacity to represent God in the world We are His ambassadors in the world.

Too often people get their identity from culture, vocation, accumulation of material things, or even from our human sexuality. However, our identity really comes from being created in the image of our God. Our greatest purpose is in reflecting that image to the world. In every sense, we have been created to love God and our neighbor.

This is where we get our identity. Let's mirror that image as we enjoy this life together.
