A WORD FROM PASTOR JON



The Purpose of the Law

As we have been looking at Paul's letter to the Church of Rome and his reflection on the Law, we can't help but ask what is the purpose of the Law? To get a more complete understanding we must go back to when God delivered the Hebrew people out of slavery in Egypt.

This was, as Timothy Tennant says, "a central orienting event" (p24). This event is remembered

and celebrated to this day as Passover and it is the focal point of their identity as a people.

The Hebrews were delivered from slavery not just to be liberated, but also to live as God's chosen people, which was a greater service by living a life of holiness. They where going to model what it meant to be a covenant people and the Law provided a picture of what life was meant to look like for a covenant people.

All the commandments of the Old Testament are a summary of God's Law and teach us how to live and be faithful to God and our neighbor. These commandments are God's way of showing us the need for a human reorientation or as mentioned in our coverage of Romans 8, a "rebrand".

The best summary of the Law was given by Jesus when he summarized them into loving God and neighbor. But it was our inability to live out the Law that demonstrated our need for salvation. Paul said in Galatians 3:24 that the Law was a "tutor to lead us to Christ".

So, Jesus has led us out of even a greater captivity (sin & death) and brought us into a new creation. So, we see that the deepest purpose of the Law was to lead us to Christ.

I highly recommend the book *Thirty Questions* by Timothy Tennent. It has 30 chapters each only about two small pages in length. All foundational subjects of our Christian faith. There will be some at each church if you would like to purchase one.


